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# BYLAWS <br> OF <br> 32ND STFEET STORAGE OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC. 

## ARTICLE 1

Name and Location
The name of the corporation is 32nd Street Storage Owners' Association, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "Association". The principal office of the corporation shall be located at 2241 $32^{\text {nd }}$ Street, Spirit Lake, IA 51360 , but meetings of members and Directors may be held at such places within the State of Iowa, County of Dickinson, as may be designated by the Board of Directors.

## ARTICLE II

Definitions
Terms used in these Bylaws shall have the same meaning as in the Association Articles of Incorporation and the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, Easements and Restrictions for $32^{\text {nd }}$ Street Storage (hefeinafter "Declaration").

## ARTICLE III

Meeting of Members
Section 1. Amual Meeting. The first annual meeting of the members shall be held within one year from the date of incorporation of the Association, and each subsequent regular annual meeting of the members shall be held on the same day of the same month of each year thereafter, at the hour of 7:00 p.m. If the day for the annual meeting of the members is a legal holiday, the meeting will be held at the same hour on the first day following, which is not a legal holiday.

Section 2. Special Meetings. Special meetings of the members may be called at any time by the president of by the Board of Directors, or upon written request of the members who are entitied to vote one-half ( $1 / 2$ ) of all the votes to the membership, or upon written request of the Developer.

Section 3. Notice of Meeting. Written notice of each meeting of the members shall be given by, or at the direction of, the secretary or person authorized to call the meeting, by mailing a copy of such motice, postage prepaid, at least ten (10) days nor more than thirty (30) days before such meeting to each member entitled to vote, addressed to the member's address last appearing in the books of the Association, or supplied by such member to the Association for the purpose of notice. Such notice shall specify the place, day and hour of the meeting, and, in the case of a special meeting, the purpose of the neeting.

Section 4. Quorum. The presence at the meeting of members entitled to cast, or of proxies entitled to cast, one-half (1/2) of the votes of the membership shall constitute a quorum for any action except as otherwise provided in the Articles of Incorporation, the Declaration, or these Bylaws If, however, the required quorum is not forthcoming at any such meeting, another mecting may be called subject to the notice requirements herein and the required quorum at any such subsequent meeting shall be onc-third (1/3) of the votes of the mernbership, provided such subsequent meeting shall be held thirty (30) days following such preceding meeting.

Section 5. Proxies. At all meetings of members, each member may vote in person or by proxy. All proxies shall be in writing and filed with the secretary. Every proxy shall be revocable and shall automatically cease upon conveyance by the member of his/her/its Unit.

ARTICLE IV
Baaxd of Directors: Selection: Term of Office
Section 1. Number. The affairs of this Association shall be managed by a Board of not less than one (1) no more than six (6) Directors, who shall be members of the Association.

Section 2. Term of Office. At each annual meeting the members entitled to vote shall elect two (2) of the six (6) Directors for a period of two (2) years on a rotating basis.

Section 3. Removal. Any Director may be removed from the Board, with or without cause, by a majority vote of the members of the Association. In the event of death, resignation or removal of a Director, his successor shall be selected by the remaining members of the Board and shall serve for the unexpired term of his predecessor.

Section 4. Compensation. No Director shall receive compensation for any service he may render to the Association, Howeyer, any Director may be reimbursed for his actual preapproved expenses incurred in the performance of his/her duties.

Section 5. Action Taken Without a Meeting. The Directors shall have the right to take any action in the absence of a meeting which they could take at a meating by obtaining the written approval of all the Directors. Any action so approved sball have the same effect as thought taken at a fectrig of the Directors.

## ARTICLE V

Nomination and Election of Directors
Section 1. Nomination. Nomination for election to the Board of Directors shall be made by a Nominatheg Committee. Nominatious may also be made from the floor at the annual meeting. The Nominatiag Committee shall consist of a Chairman, who shall be a member of the Board of Directors, and two or more members of the Association. The Nominating Committee shall be appointed by the Board of Directors prior to each annual meeting of the members, to serve from the close of such annual meeting until the close of the next annual meeting and such appointment shall be announced at each annual meeting. The Nominating Committee shall make as many nominations for election to the Board of Directors as it shal! in its discretion determine, but not less than the number of vacancies that are to be filled. Such nominations shall be made from among membets of the Association.

Section 2. Election. Election to the Board of Directors shall be by secret written ballot. At such election, the members or their proxies may cast, in respect to each vacancy, as many votes as they are entitied to exercise under the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation. The persor receiving the largest number of votes shall be elected. Cumulative voting is not permitted

## -ARTICLE VI

Meetings of Directors
Section 1. Regular Meetings. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shali be held quarterly without notice, at such place and hour as may be fixed from time to time by resolution of the Board. Should said meeting fall upon a legal holiday, then that meeting shall be held at the same time on the next day, which is not a legal holiday.

Section 2. Special Meetings. Special meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held when called by the president of the Association, or by any two ditectors, after not less than three (3) days notice to each Director.

Section 3. Quorum. A majority of the number of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Every act of decision done or made by a majority of the Directors present at a duly held meeting at which a quorum is present shall be regarded as the act of the Board.

## ARTICLE VII

Powers and Duties of the Board of Directors
Section 1. Powers. The Board of Directors shall have the power to:
(a) Adopt and publish rules and regulations governing the use of the Common Area facilities, and the personal conduct of the members and their guests thereon, and to establish penalties for the infraction thereof;
(b) Suspend the voting rights and right to use of the common facilities of a member duritge any period in which such member shall be in default in the payment of any assessment levied by the Association. Such rights may also be suspended after notice and hearing, for a period not to exceed 60 days, for infraction of published rules and regulations;
(c) Exercise for the Association all powers, duties and authority vested in or delegated to this Association and not reserved to the membership by other provisions of these Bylaws, the Articles of Incorporation or the Declaration;
(d) Declare the office of a member of the Board of Directors to be vacant in the event such member shall be absent from three (3) consectitive regular meetings of the Board of Directors; and
-(a) - - Employ-a manager, an-independent-contractor-or-such-other-employees-as-they deem necessary, and to prescribe their duties.

Section 2. Duties. It shall be the duty of the Board of Directors to:
(a) Cause to be kept a complete record of all its acts and corporate affairs and to present a statement thereof to the members at the annual meeting of the members, or at any special meeting wheres such statement is requested in writing by two-thirds ( $2 / 3$ ) of the members who are entitled to vote;
(b) Superise all officers agents and employees of this Association, and to see that their duties are properly performed;
(c) Fix the amount of the annual assessment 日gainst each Unit at least thirty (30) days in advance of each annual assessment pertod;
(d) Send written notice of each assessment to every Owner subject thereto at least thirty (30) days in advance of each annual assessment period;
(e) Foreclose the lien against any property for which assessments are not paid within thity (30) days after due date or to bring an action at law against the owner personally obligated to pay the same;
(f) Issue, or cause an appropriate officer to issue, upon demand by any person, a certificate setting forth whether or not any assessment has been paid. A reasonable charge may be made by the Board for the issuance of these certificates. If a certificate states an assessment has been paid, such certificate shall be conclusive evidence of such payment;
(g) Procure and maintain adequate liability and hazard insurance on property owned by the Association;
(h) Cause all officers or enuployees having fiscal responsibilities to be bonded, as it may deem apyropriate; and
(i) Cause the Common Areas and the Association responsibility elements to be maintained.

## ARTICLE VIII

## Officers and Their Duties

Section 1. Enumeration of Offices. The officers of this Association shall be a president and/or vice president, who shall at all times be members of the Board of Directors, a secretary and/or a treasurer, and such other officers as the Board may from time to time by resolution create.

Section 2. Election of Officers. The election of officers shall take place at the first meeting of the Board of Directors following each annual neeting of the members.

Section 3. Term. The officers of the Association shall be elected annually by the Board and each shall hold office for one (1) year unless helshe shall sooner resign, or shall be removed, or otherwise be disquatified to serve.

Section 4. Special Appointments. The Board may elect such other officers as the affairs of the Association may require, each of whom shall hold office for such period, have such authority and perform such duties as the Board may, from time to time, determine,

Section 5. Resignation and Removal. Any officer may be removed from office with or without cause by the Board. Any officer may tesign at any time giving written notice to the Board, the president or the pecretary. Such resignation shall take effect on the date of receipt of such notice or at any later time specified therein, and unless otherwise specified therein, the acceptance of such resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective.

Section 6. Vacancies. A vacancy in any office may be filled by appointment by the Board. The officer appointed to such vacancy shall serve for the remainder of the term of the officer he/she replaces.

Section 7. Duties. The duties of the officers are as follow;

## PRESIDENT

(a) The president shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors and shall see that orders and resolutions of the Board are carried out.

VICE RRESIDENT
(b) The vice president shall act in the place and stead of the president in the event of his absence, inability or refusal to act and shall exercise and discharge such other duties as may be requised of himhtry-the Board.

## SECRETARY

(c) The secretary shall record the votes and keep the minutes of all meatings and proceedings of the Board and of the members; serve notice of meetings of the Board and of the members; keep appropriate carfent records showing the members of the Association together with their addresses; and shall perform such other duties as required by the Board.

## TREASURER

(d) The treasurer shall receive and deposit in appropriate bank accounts all monies of the Association and shall disburse such funds as directed by resolution of the Board of Directors; shall sign all checks and promissory notes of the Association; keep proper books of account; cause an annual audit of the Assaciation books to be made by a public accountant at the completion of each fiscal year; and shall prepare an annual budget and a statement of income and expenditurate to be presented to the membership at its regular annual meeting, and delivery a copy to each of the members.

## ARTICLE IX <br> Committees

The Board of Direotors may appoint such committees as it deems appropriate in earrying out its purpose.

## ARTICLE X

Books and Records
The books, records and papers of the Association shall at all times, during reasonable business hours, be subject to inspection by any member. The Declaration, the Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws of the Association shall be available for inspection by any member at the principal office of the Association, where copies may be purchased at reasonable cost.

## ARTICLE XI

Assessments
As more fully provided in the Declaration, each member is obligated to pay the Association annual and special assessments which are secured by a continuing lien upon the property against which the assessment is made. Any assessments which are not paid when due shatl be delinquent. If the assessment is not paid within thirty ( 30 ) days after the due date the assessment shall bear interest from the date of delinquency at the rate of twelve (12) percent per annum, and the Association may bring an action at law against the Owner personally obligated to pay the assessment. The costs and reasonable attomey's fees of any such sction shall be added to the amount of such essessment. No Owner may waive or otherwise escape liability for the assessments provided for herein by nonuse of the Common Area or abandonment of his/her Unit.

ARTICLE XII<br>Corporate Seal

The Association shall not have a seal.

## ARTICLE XIII

## Amendments

Section 1. These Bylaws may be amended, at a regular or special meeting of the members, by a vote of $3 / 4$ ths of the total votes eligible to be cast at a meeting at which there is a quorum of members preseat in person or by proxy.

Section 2. In the case of any conflict between the Articles of Incorporation and these Bylaws, the Articles shal! control; mand in the case of any conflict between a Declaration and these Bylaws, a Declaration shall control.
